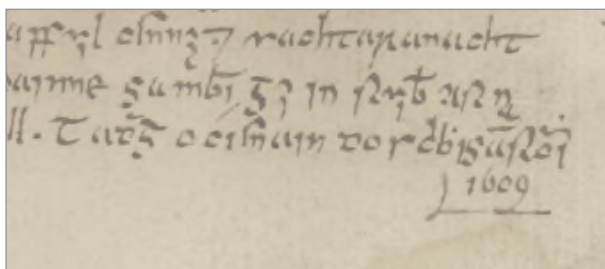

The weekend focuses on the account of the Earls' journey from Donegal to Rome written by their historian Tadhg Ó Cianáin and also involves a reflection on the impact of 2007-8 commemorative events in Ireland and Europe.

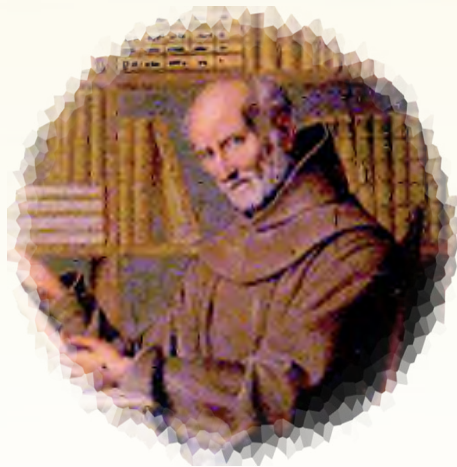
